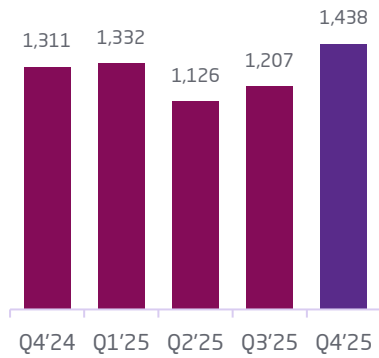

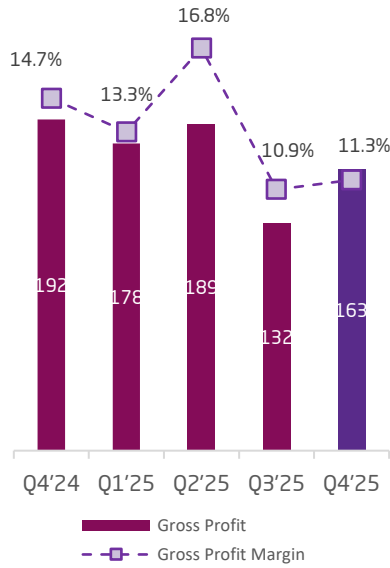

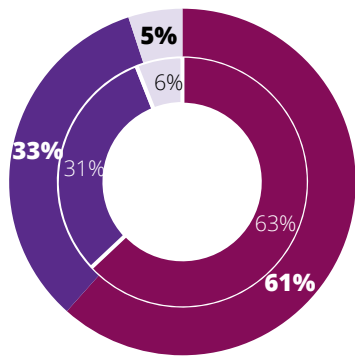
Revenue, SAR Million



Gross Profit, SAR Million

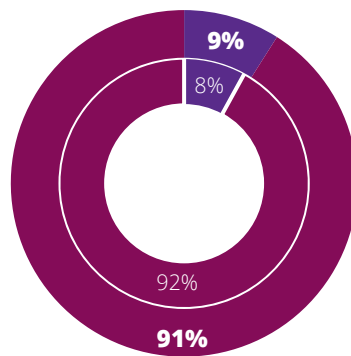


Revenue by Division



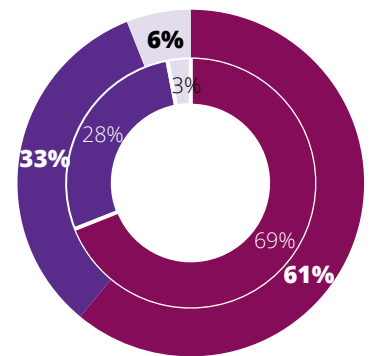

■ Online ■ Stores

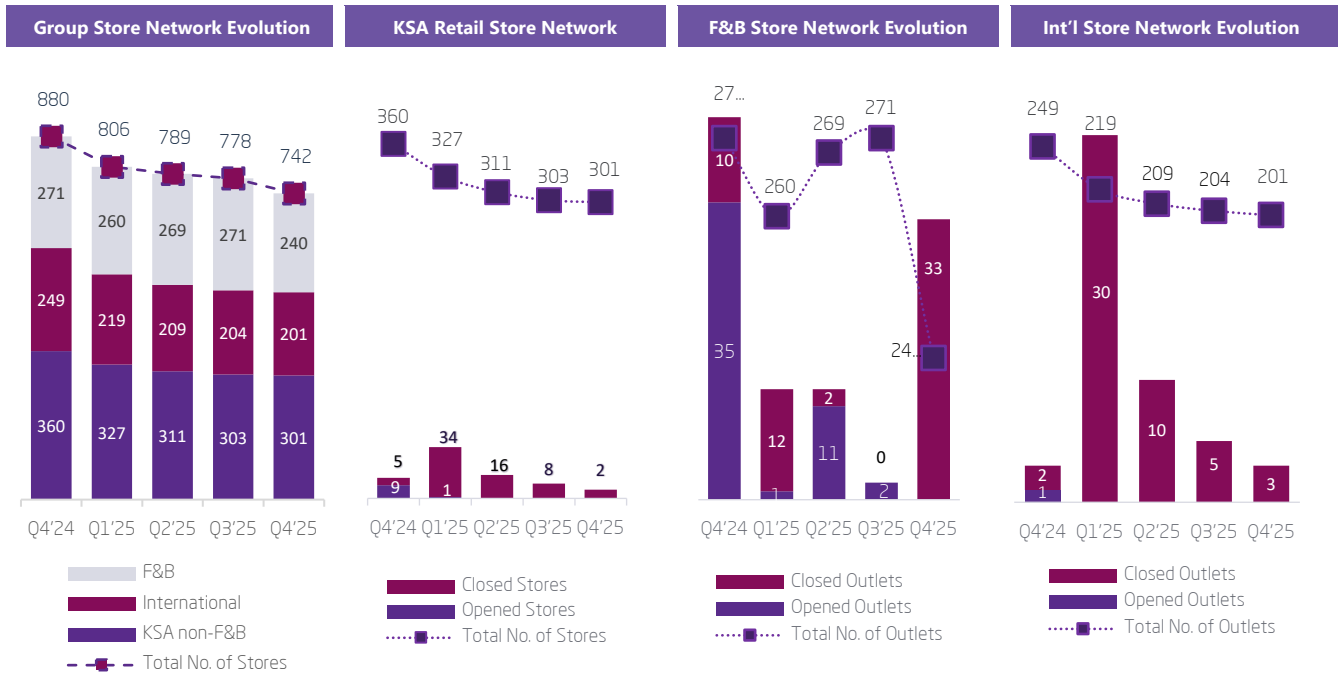
Revenue by Geography
